#### **OVERVIEW**

Founded in 1968, Rocky Mount Academy is an independent, coeducational, college preparatory day school for students in grades PK-12. Located on 41 wooded acres in suburban Rocky Mount, North Carolina, the school draws students from seven surrounding counties. Fully accredited and with a low student/teacher ratio, RMA seeks to prepare its students for the challenges, opportunities, and responsibilities they will encounter in life and college. Students are challenged to go beyond simply learning information to actively engaging in their own education by analyzing, creating, and applying critical thinking skills in their courses. RMA students are offered a wide range of athletic, co-curricular, and extra-curricular activities.

### CLASS RANK

Given the graduating class size, academic strength of students, and rigorous college preparatory curriculum, individual class rank is not considered a valid measure of a student's achievement and is not computed. Valedictorian and salutatorian are recognized at graduation.

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum of 23 units required for graduation:

- 4 units of English
- 4 units of mathematics, one course each year and at least one unit beyond Algebra II
- 3 units of science, including a life science, a physical science, and a lab science
- 3 units of history, including US History
- 2 units of foreign language

- 1 trimester course in Computer App and Public Speaking
- A grade point average (GPA) of 70 or above
- Participation in Advisory Program and one team sport
- Satisfactory completion of all service hours (50 hours)
- Satisfactory completion of summer reading requirements

Beyond these graduation requirements, specific course requirements exist for 9th grade. These courses include Art I and Music I  $\,$  .

### COVID-19 RESPONSE

In March 2020, Rocky Mount Academy's students did not return from Winter Break, and students and faculty engaged in virtual distance learning for the remainder of the academic year. Courses continued with typical rigor through May 15, 2020, with final grades posted on June 1, 2020. We began the 2020–2021 school year in a hybrid model with the majority of students choosing to attend class in-person and some attending online synchronously or asynchronously. Class sizes were reduced to allow for social distancing in the classroom, limiting elective options for some students. Our transcripts will appear identical to pre-COVID transcripts, and our counselor recommendation and this secondary school report will reflect anything remarkable from Spring trimester 2020 through Spring trimester 2021.
